Students receive free admission to athletic events (other than conference playoffs) and most concerts, lectures, and drama productions.

³ Study Abroad Grant Fee is used to provide financial support for undergraduate students seeking to participate in a variety of study abroad experiences to include semester programs, international immersion programs, and international business, government, and non-government organization internships.

⁴ The Information Services Fee supports a wide variety of services provided to all St. Mary's students. These services include but not limited to bandwidth, WiFi, infrastructure upgrades, student printing, information security systems, library databases, research journals, Canvas system components and classroom technology upgrades.
